For over twenty years I have prepared memoranda on complex legal issues for the District Court of Amsterdam and have draughted the judgements of this court in complex cases.

Organisational / managerial skills

My duties as legal advisor to the District Court of Amsterdam require me to organize the preparation of particularly complex legal cases in such a way, that:

- all parties to proceedings are made aware of the relevant issues the court will address well in advance of the hearing;
- the court possesses all information relevant for conducting the hearing in an effective and expeditious manner;
- the court can reach a decision *in camera* in a structured manner;
- the judgment of the court is clear, convincing and in line with previous case law.
