28 June 11.00 Future perspective: third level of protection

- Bringing it all together
- All interests involved
- All stakeholders
- => one single joint procedure in two stages: 1. hearing before the issuing jud. authority;
- 2. hearing before the executing jud. auth





A Model for an EAW.next.level

- arrest in exec. MS
- video-hearing in issuing MS on:
- 1. National AW; 2. EAW
- On EAW: proportionality (both MSs and requested person)
- Issuing MS: EAW or alternative
- Executing MS: is executing EAW proportional? (new circumstances)
